**A limited number of personalization opportunities are still available.**

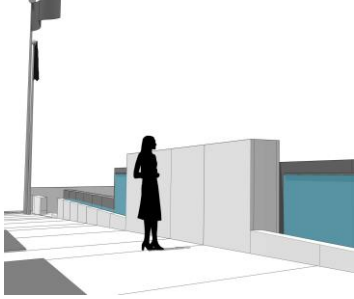

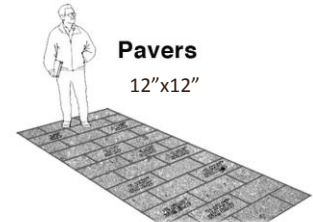
